



Temple Bar TradFest to bring family fun

TEMPLE Bar TradFest returns at the end of this month, promising a host of events and performances for all the family. The festival – which takes place in **Temple Bar**, Dublin from January 26 to 30 – includes some 200 free events as well as two outdoor stages bringing music to the cobbled streets of the capital. Held in association with Dublin City Council, **TradFest** also features an extensive family programme, with The Ark playing host to the virtuoso musical brothers Barc6, as well as the Cunningham Family Sean-n6s dancers and musicians. Elsewhere, Airfield, Dublin's only working urban farm, will move from its home in Dundrum into the city, bringing goats, sheep, hens and calves. There will also be street performers, Irish dancing and, of course, lots of great music.
